Scholastic Book Fair

Next week, we are hosting a Scholastic Book Fair, raising monies for new books in school. Pupils will be able to preview the books during class time on Friday to see if there are any books or stationary that they would like to buy. You will be able to purchase any books via a QR code, contactless system (not available on Tuesday) or cash. If your child is on the bus or attends ASC, they can bring cash in, but they are responsible for keeping their cash secure in a school bag during the day. There is also a competition, where pupils can win a £5 book voucher towards the cost of an item they would like to buy. Vouchers will be awarded to the winners on Monday. To enter the competition, your child must hand in a book-cover design of their favourite story to their class teacher by Monday morning. A template has been provided, but they do not have to use this.

This is a fantastic and popular fundraising event that inspires children to read and helps school with maintaining our excellent selection of books.
