### **NUT FREE SCHOOL – Sun cream**

Just a reminder that we are a nut free school. All lunches should be completely nut free so please ensure you check the ingredients on any packaging.

Could you also check the ingredients on bottles of sun cream that your child may bring in to school, specifically for arachidyl glucoside or arachidyl alcohol, which are peanut derivatives or Prunus Amygdalus Dulcis Oil which is almond oil.
