Religious Education is taught in accordance with the Cumbrian Agreed Syllabus for RE 2023 which is rooted in the disciplinary approaches of theology, philosophy and human sciences.

Theology: This is about thinking through believing. It looks at where beliefs come from, how they have changed over time, how they are applied differently in different contexts and how they relate to each other.

Philosophy: This is about thinking through thinking. It is about finding out how and whether things make sense. It deals with questions of morality and ethics. It takes seriously the nature of reality, knowledge and existence.

Human Sciences: This is about thinking through living. It explores the diverse ways in which people practise their beliefs. It engages with the impact of beliefs on individuals, communities and societies.
