A score of zero = national average Where confidence intervals are above zero, pupils are doing significantly better than nationally.

Comments – NB: very small cohort of 8 pupils so apply caution to statistics

We are very proud of our excellent results! We judge them to be very good/outstanding (so continuing our trend of outstanding outcomes at KS2 over the last 5 years) because...

- Our school meets & exceeds well above the current government floor & coasting standards (2018 floor standards: 64% pupil reach expected standard in R+W+Ma combined or sufficient progress scores achieved in all 3 subjects of at least -5 in Reading/Maths & -7 in Writing; coasting standards progress scores at least -2.5 Reading/Maths, -3.5 Writing).
- Attainment: 2018 figures are above 2017's results for Reading at greater depth (so continuing the trend of significant improvement in Reading at greater depth since 2016), in line with 2017 for Writing at expected & greater depth & for GPS at expected. Other subjects are below 2017's, but are all higher than 2016's, apart from GPS at greater depth.
- Our school results are well above national & county figures at the expected standard and in achievement of the higher standard (score of 110+) in all separate subject results, apart from in GPS at greater depth, where they are just below. Our results are below national & county for achievement of the higher standard in R+W+Ma combined, as happened in 2016; but 1 child (13%) missed achieving this by being just 1 mark below greater depth in Reading. Target: to secure at least national combined score for greater depth in 2019.
- Our average scaled scores for attainment in Reading and Maths are high & above 2016's. Target: to raise scores in GPS (increase achievement at greater depth in GPS).
- Progress: our 2018 scores are excellent much higher than national average & Cumbria (2017) figures, especially in Writing, which is significantly above average. They are all higher than 2017 figures & show especially good progress in Reading since 2016. Target: to maintain & further raise progress scores by achieving more at greater depth & securing progress for high prior-attaining pupils & mobile pupils.
