- ✓ Please communicate with us- we want to help to remove barriers.






Expectations: Equipment

Sanctions

We give students the opportunity to correct behaviour and 'do the right thing' before it escalates.



Every child has the right to learn in an environment free from disruption.

In lesson:

Chance- verbal warning (no negative attached)
Change- formal warning (C1 negative point given)
Consequence- removal (C2 after school detention)

Lates: continuous lates to school or lessons = after school detention

Out of lesson misconduct = after school detention

At the end of each term, we **reward those who do the right thing day in, day out**. Examples of past rewards include- inflatable obstacle course, silent disco, Christmas movie and popcorn & a school rock concert.
