




Bookstart

Understanding your child's behaviour

The Solihull Approach parenting group includes a range of strategies to enhance parent/child relationships. Activities are designed to encourage a reflective style of parenting that leads to more sensitive and effective parenting. Parents are also helped to understand how they can influence their relationship with their child through play. The group is designed to help parents identify their own objectives.

We offer a range of services to support children and young people aged 5 – 19 years

ishes & Feelings 5 – 8 yrs

Wishes and Feelings is a 6-week intervention which is used directly with the child on a 1-1 basis to give them the opportunity to discuss their thoughts and feelings and try to work through some of their worries.

Decider Skills 8+ yrs

The Decider Skills are 12 Cognitive Behavioural Therapy skills designed to help children and young people to recognise their own thoughts, feelings and behaviours, allowing them to monitor and manage their own emotions. They enable individuals to make effective changes in how they manage distress, regulate emotion and communicate effectively. The skills are usually taught over 6 weeks, and can be delivered directly to the child, or as a family to help the parent to support their child.

Drawing and Talking 7+ yrs

Drawing and Talking is a child-centred therapy focusing on prevention, early intervention and recovery. This is a 12-week intervention to support those who have suffered trauma or have underlying emotional difficulties. It helps children to become more able to control their behaviour, access the academic curriculum, and increases their self-esteem.



Early Help

Our Child and Family Support workers can offer families who are facing challenges early help and support in their own homes.

We will work with your family to support you and your child, and with your agreement, a worker will ask you and your child some questions to find out what help and support you and your child might need. This information is recorded on a simple form called an Early Help Assessment. You and your child will agree what is put on the form, and this will help to identify your child's needs and other workers required to support your family.

Supporting Families Team

The supporting Families Team works in partnership with Cumbria County Council to provide support for local families. Together they can help to make a bright future for your family.

This team can:

We will work with your family to support you and your child, and with your agreement, a worker will ask you and your child some questions to find out what help and support you and your child assisting to remove barriers to work (e.g. upfront assisting to remove barriers).

assisting to remove barriers to work (e.g. upfront childcare costs, initial travel costs, clothes for interviews), and in situations where you may have recently lost a job or been made redundant

- Provide support for setting up your own business and with improving qualifications (e.g. apprenticeships, training, and so on)
- Carry out a skills audit to help you find jobs that suit your skills, help to update your CV, and support with online job searching
- Help you if you have a disability and would like to work, using the Governments 'Right to Work' scheme where appropriate.

SUMMIT 22

Our long awaited follow up survey to Summit 17, known as Summit 22, is now available for your child(ren) or young person aged 8-13 years old to take part in! To be eligible to take part, the children must be aged between 8-13 years old and live, even if part of the time, in Cumbria. On behalf of the project, we would like to thank our Cumbria County Council Local Committees who have kindly donated funds which have enabled us to follow up on this survey.

The questions within the Survey have stayed the same so that we can compare this year's answers with the previous survey from 2017, as much has happened since then that has shaped not only our lives, but our children and young people's lives living in Cumbria. We are asking any participants to tick if they took part in 2017 (noting that all responses were anonymous) as well as increasing the options for them to select how they identify with an option to choose not to disclose.

All the fields in the survey require a response.

We have seen significant growth in services in Cumbria specifically for this age range so would welcome your support in ensuring that they are given the opportunity to consider completing this. We am keen, as we move forward, to continue to seek the voices of children and young people as a means of stress testing, challenging or validating our professional or indeed personal views in respect of how they may be feeling or thinking, so that we can continue to co-design and co-produce services that are based on unmet need, relevance and impact.

You can complete the form online by following our QR Code below (all responses will automatically be fed into a secure database which we will then review), or, if you do not have access to this, call by one of our Children's Centre's and we can give you a paper copy which can then be returned once filled in.
