This Term ...

Topic: Our main topic for this term is a geographical topic - The UK! We will be learning about the four different countries, the main cities and landmarks as well as what makes each country unique whilst comparing to other countries around the world.

English: Our English will start off with report writing skills based on our Geography topic. We will move onto non-fiction writing, also based on nocturnal animals as the term progresses. When we get our first taste of frost, we will develop our poetry skills by writing based on first-hand experience.

Maths: Year 1 children will be learning about adding and subtraction up to 20 (and beyond for those more confident). Year 2 children will be learning about multiplication and division (we tend to call them groups in Class 2). We will also be learning about measurements (length and height)
