This Term ...

Topic: Our main topic for this term is a historical topic - Kings and Queens. I am sure it will be an exciting topic for both the girls and boys in Class 2!

English: We will start off the term reading the story of St George and the Dragon (leading up to St. George's Day). We will continue into the next week with some poetry inspired by the story "Tell Me Your Dragon", followed by learning about really kings and queens from our history. We will of course be learning about Queen Elizabeth II, but also learn about Queen Victoria and King Henry VIII.

Maths: Year 1 children will be learning about multiplication and division before moving onto fractions (halves and quarters). Year 2 children will be learning about measuring length and height before moving on to position and direction.
