How have we spent our funding in 2024-2025?

Principles

At Orton CE School, we recognise the important contribution of P.E. to the health and well-being of our children. We believe that an innovative, varied P.E. curriculum and a range of extra-curricular opportunities have a positive influence on the self-esteem, concentration, attitude, confidence and academic achievement of our children.

As in previous years our Primary School Sports' Funding has enabled us to extend and strengthen our provision in a range of ways.

How we used the funding in 2024/25.

- 1) Service Level Agreement with Eden Valley Sports Partnership which provided:
 - 3 blocks of external coaches for a range of outdoor sports. These coaches lead sporting activities
 and work alongside teachers as CPD to develop sustainable improvements in quality of teaching.
 - A wide range of festivals, tournaments and CPD.
- 2) Purchase of new PE balance equipment.
- 3) Additional TA/ PE coach staff to deliver PE lessons in school.
- 4) Weekly free to families After School Club Sports Clubs Zumba, Razzamatazz, Cheerleading.
- 5) Residentials for Years 3 & 4 to Hawse End to experience a range of physical activities.
- 6) Transport to sporting events.
- 7) Two weeks of Swimming for the whole school from Nursery to Year 6
- 8) Swimming enrichments days Life Saving for Years 5&6 and swimming enrichment day for EYFS
- 9) Life Education & subscription to Coram SCARF Materials to deliver Health and Relationships Curriculum.
- 10) Wheelchair Rugby Day

Evaluation

What impact has the sport funding had on our PE and Sport provision?

- Our priority has been to keep our children happy and active both in school and at home. Our children
 have demonstrated that they are generally happy, school is a very happy place.
- 100% of KS2 have had the opportunity to participate in competitive inter-school sports and represented the school with confidence and great sporting attitude.
- 100% of Reception & KS1children have had the opportunity to attend festivals in multi-skills and gymnastics.
- 100% of the Year 6 children who had been with us since at least year 5 met the expected standard in swimming.







- Staff have learned from coaches who have been in school and from CPD resulting in improved quality
 of P.E. teaching throughout the school.
- Successful partnership work on Physical Education with other schools within our cluster, and with our local secondary schools.
- Range of sports offered means children have the confidence to get involved with out of school clubs and sport at secondary schools.
- PE balance equipment is helping to develop proprioception in children especially EYFS.
- All children have improved and developed their physical skills.
- Our children are motivated to be active and they love PE and playtimes. Playtimes are very active with the vast majority of children choosing to play games that require a significant amount of physical exertion.
- EYFS children have gained confidence in water following their enrichment day.
- Year 5 & 6 children have gained water life-saving skills & basic first aid training.
- At least one free active Breakfast or After School Sports Club a week continues to be well received and always has high numbers of children attending.
- One of our children qualified for and ran in the County Cross Country Championships.
- 100% of Key Stage 2 children took part in residentials and associated activities.
- 100% children have experienced what it is like to use a wheelchair and heard from a wheelchair user about their experiences of life.
- The RSHE curriculum is succinct across school and is continuously kept up to date
