Then a man with a disease called leprosy came to him and Jesus healed him. Jesus went to the home of Peter's Mother-in-law, who had a fever: Jesus held her hand and the fever went; and finally a Roman soldier came to Jesus and said that his servant was sick and Jesus told the soldier that by the time he got back to his house his servant would be better.

Jesus and his disciple were all very tired by now - and got into a boat to have a rest away from the crowds. It was a calm day and Jesus immediately fell asleep, but suddenly the wind began to blow harder and harder and a great storm swept across the water, but Jesus just slept on.

The disciples were very scared - they thought they were going to drown and as the boat was tossed violently about they woke Jesus, saying "Jesus, save us! We are going to drown!"

Jesus asked them, "Why are you so afraid?" Then he got up and told the winds and waves to stop and the water became completely calm again.

He turned to his friends and said "You did not need to be frightened, you only needed to trust me."

Although most of us will not be in the position that the disciples were in, we do all have our own "storms" when we are afraid or worried about something. Jesus is always with us and will help us if we only ask him.
