Dear Parents/Carers,

With the exam season upon us we write to inform you of some important dates and associated operational changes that are set to roll out this summer term.

Year 11 leaving date/exam arrangements

Following consultation with other schools we have decided that all Year 11 students will finish their on-site studies with us on Friday 26th May. Thereafter they will only be expected to attend school for their scheduled exams. For students who travel to school by taxi, transport will be organised accordingly, but at a slightly earlier collection time. Can we emphasize that all students must attend school in full school uniform on all exam days.

Operational changes on core exam days.

The dates below represent the days on which the core exams of English and Maths will take place. On these days all rooms will be required for exam purposes and as such we have no alternative but to close the school to all other students until 12 noon on these days:
