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| <p>KS3 Outreach programme</p> <p>6 x 1hr sessions</p> | <p>This programme is intended to target students in the early weeks of disruption/demonstration of concerning behaviours. Ideally it will involve working with 2/3 students who are beginning to show signs of disaffection and noncompliance. The programme will help students to better understand and maintain their own emotional state. Focused out of class intervention and in lesson support/observation at the students' main stream school is also a feature of the programme</p> | <p>£420 per 6-week programme</p> |
| <p>KS2 Outreach programme</p> <p>6x 1hr sessions</p> | <p>This programme is intended to target very early intervention at KS2. This could be to support with behaviour interventions, creation of behaviour support plans, IEP writing and lesson observations and meeting with parents. This programme will help support staff and students. This is carried out by a qualified SENDCo who is a specialist teacher also.</p> | <p>£470 per 6-week programme</p> |
| <p>KS3 intervention programme</p> <p>6-week programme with a start date and end date for all attending students.</p> | <p>For students who are at risk of permanent exclusion.</p> <p>Themed course with a big focus on literacy, numeracy, social emotional development and mentoring/agency intervention. First 4 weeks full time, week 5-6 will involve 1 or 2 days in the student's mainstream setting, supported by an outreach worker for an hour/week.</p> | <p>£40 per day</p> <p>Plus, transport costs if required.</p> |

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| <p>Year 10 intervention programme</p> <p>6-week programme with a start date and end date for all attending students.</p> | <p>For students who are at risk of permanent exclusion.</p> <p>A traditional curriculum will be followed with a big focus on Maths, English and Science with mentoring/agency intervention.</p> <p>First 4 weeks full time, week 5-6 will involve 1 or 2 days in the student's mainstream setting, supported by an outreach worker for an hour/week.</p> | <p>£40 per day</p> <p>Plus, transport costs if required.</p> |
| <p>Year 10/11 Transition programme</p> <p>Long term placement at Oswaldtwistle school/AP setting</p> | <p>Intended for students who are struggling to access the mainstream curriculum and who require a long-term, full-time placement. English and maths will be followed with the possibility of science plus 2 options. For an additional cost AP courses are available 2 days per week. Students will work alongside PEX students.</p> | <p>£40 per day</p> <p>Plus, transport costs if required. AP can be offered at additional cost.</p> |
| <p>Mental health and wellbeing support programme for KS3 and KS4</p> <p>2 full term placement</p> | <p>This offer is for students who are suffering from anxiety, depression and other mental health issues which may be impacting on their attendance and academic progress. The programme operates away from the main building and focuses on supporting young people with their emotional struggles. A broad and balanced curriculum offer is available if students are able to access it.</p> | <p>£40 per day</p> <p>Plus, transport costs if required.</p> |
