Dear Parents/Guardians,

Earlier this year we made the decision to review our school uniform following concerns raised by our students in regard to the comfort and smartness of our current uniform and problems linked to our supplier. Following discussions with staff and members of the student council it was decided that we would move in the direction of not only new jumpers but also ties. The council opted once again for black jumpers, but of an improved fabric, and black and grey ties for year 11 students and blue and black ties for students in years 7-10.

We have decided that ties should be available on a refundable deposit basis and so if returned in a useable state at the end of their time with us, then pupils/families will be reimbursed with £5.

The cost of the uniform is as follows;

The new school uniform will be an **expectation as of Monday 5th September 2022** and as such uniform items are now available from both ourselves and the uniform shop in Accrington. As new students arrive with us this side of the summer break the uniform will no doubt start to filter in to school, and as such if you wish your child to transition to the new uniform sooner than September then we would support this.

Please note that our own school uniform only needs to be purchased by families/carers of students who are with us on a permanent basis. For all students who are with us for a short period of time and remain on their main school roll it is expected that they will attend wearing the full school uniform of their mainstream school.
