Dear Parents/Carers,

With the exam season upon us we write to inform you of some important dates and associated operational changes that are set to roll out this summer term.

Year 11 leaving date/exam arrangements

Following consultation with other schools we have decided that all Year 11 students will finish their on-site studies with us on Friday 22nd May. Thereafter they will only be expected to attend school for their scheduled exams. For students who travel to school by taxi, transport will be organised accordingly, but at a slightly earlier collection time. Can we emphasize that all students must attend school in full school uniform on all exam days.

Operational changes on core exam days.

The dates below represent the days on which the core exams of English and Maths will take place. On these days all rooms will be required for exam purposes and as such we have no alternative but to close the school to all other students until 12.15pm on these days:

Thursday 14th May 2026
Thursday 21st May 2026
Wednesday 3rd June 2026
Friday 5th June 2026
Wednesday 10th June 2026



If your child's normal method of transport is by taxi, then collection times will be altered accordingly. We apologise if this causes you any inconvenience, but I am sure you will understand the importance of these exams and the need for all classrooms to be used to facilitate them.

Year 11 Results Day

School will be open to year 11 students on Thursday 20th August between 10.00am and 1.00pm for the collection of results. A few staff and careers advisors will be present to share in the successes of your child and support them in their next steps.
