Today you are going to be writing the next three paragraphs of the diary entry, either in role as Romeo or as Juliet.

Today you are going to be drafting the next three paragraphs of Juliet (or Romeo's) letter. I have modelled the start of each paragraph again for you....

### Paragraph 3

Juliet speaks of her torment that Romeo is a Montague.

O, what a quandary I now find myself in! **Deny thy father and refuse thy name**, for it is only in the name Montague that our love is not permitted. I find myself torn, but know that the heart will always triumph over anything else...

### Paragraph 4

Romeo makes his presence known. Juliet questions how he managed to be in the orchard.

Whilst engaged in mine soliloquy, he made his presence known. The words he spoke still echo in my heart; "**Call me but love, and I'll be new baptised.**" "**How came thou hither?**" were the words upon my lips, but never have I felt such joy at seeing his face...

### **Paragraph 5**

Juliet asks Romeo to declare his love and arrange their marriage.
