This week we began with an assembly in the hall celebrating the Feast of Christ the King, which marks the end of the Church's liturgical year, with the beginning starting again on Sunday 30th December with the first Sunday of Advent. The children were taught how the church's year is slightly different to the calendar year as it celebrates and commemorates the key events in the life of Jesus and begins and ends at the end of November.
