This week, we are going to start our next Talk 6 unit 'Older Literature' – Romeo and Juliet!

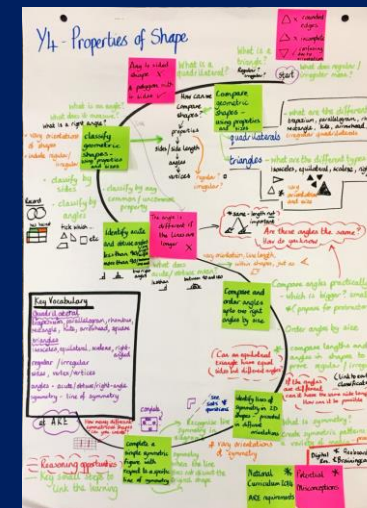
Create your own S Plan of the story. Add in the key events of the story from start to end. Draw an image for each key event. This is just another way to create a time line of events.

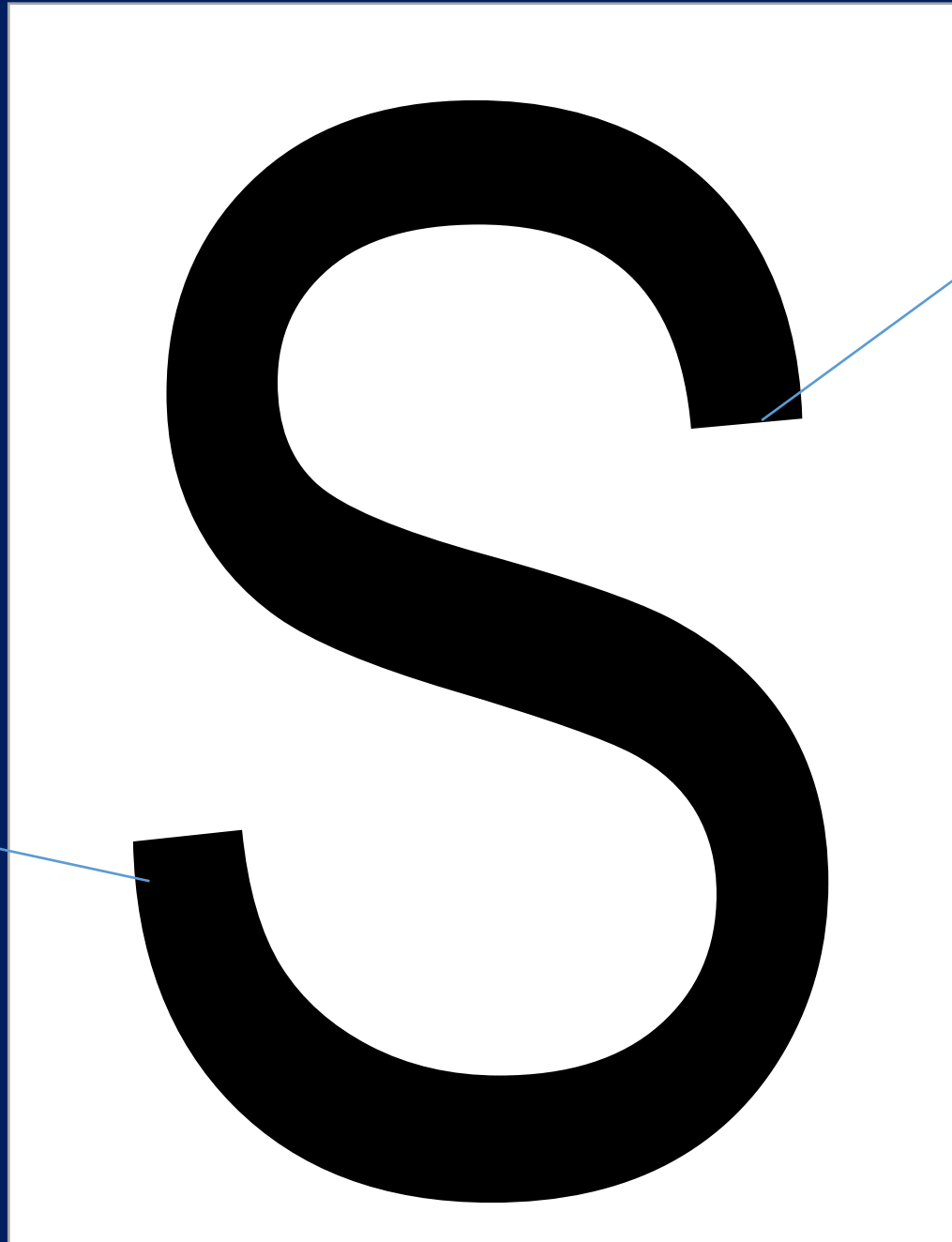
