Matthew 5: 1-12



Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, the boy of the eight beatitudes.

Beatitude	Examples of ways in which he lived out the Beatitudes.
<p><i>Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.</i></p> <p>The poor in spirit are those who know that they need God's help every day in order to be good.</p>	
<p><i>Blessed are they who mourn, for they shall be comforted.</i></p> <p>We mourn when we have been very upset by what someone has done to us. Also, we mourn when we are very sorry because we have hurt someone.</p>	
<p><i>Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth.</i></p> <p>The meek are those who are thoughtful and want to help people who are in need of love and kindness.</p>	
<p><i>Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.</i></p> <p>Blessed are those who tell the truth and stand up for what is right.</p>	

Beatitude	Examples of ways in which he lived out the Beatitudes.
<p><i>Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy.</i></p> <p>Blessed are those willing to forgive those who hurt them.</p>	
<p><i>Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.</i></p> <p>The pure in heart are those who try to make some time for God in their lives.</p>	
<p><i>Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God.</i></p> <p>Peacemakers are those who believe each person is precious; those who protect others from bullying.</p>	
<p><i>Blessed are those persecuted for righteousness sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.</i></p> <p>They are those who suffer and are made fun of because they believe in God.</p>
