HR 100 Club Rules



The object of the HR 100 Club is to raise funds for Holy Rosary Catholic Academy licensed under the Gambling Act 2005.

- The subscription to the 100 Club for one number is a one off payment of £24 to be paid by 19th October. Alternatively, you can make 10 monthly payments of £2.40, in advance. These payments must be made no later than the 19th of every month. (October July) This will give members one number which will be placed in 10 monthly draws throughout the academic year October to July. However, members may have and are encouraged to have multiple subscriptions i.e. members can have more than one number.
- Members must be 16 or over and must fill in an application form and hand to the school.
- The club is open to all parents and carers of children that attend Holy Rosary plus their family and friends. You are encouraged to get family and friends to join. The 100 Club is not limited to 100 members. The more numbers we sell, the more we raise for the school and the bigger the prizes.
- Each member is allocated a permanent number/s. This number/s shall remain the member's provided their subscription is up to date.
- The draw will take place during the last week of the month between October and July or just before we break up if it falls in a school holiday.
- A member becomes eligible for inclusion in the draw so long as the subscription has been paid and cleared before a prize draw.
- The draw will be made during a school assembly (not possible presently due to Covid restrictions) in the presence of teachers and school children.
- The prize fund will be 50% of the income according the membership numbers at the time of the draw. The remaining 50% goes to the school. There will be three prizes per draw (payable by bank transfer within 2 weeks) providing this falls within term time.

1st prize	50% of prize fund
2nd prize	30% of prize fund
3rd prize	20% of prize fund

- Winners will be contacted personally by telephone and/or email and names will be posted in the School Newsletter and on Facebook (with consent only)
- The 100 Club administrator will make all reasonable efforts to pay prizes to the winners within two weeks after the monthly draw.
- Registers will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
- Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the Club if his or her renewal of subscription remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be donated to the school after 6 months.
- The school shall also have the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 100 Club members as is necessary.
