## **OLQP Parents' Forum**

You are warmly welcomed to the first OLQP Parents' Forum Meeting of this academic year. The Parents' Forum will take place on **Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2024 at 6.00pm-7.00pm**.

The OLQP Parent Forum will work as a partnership between parents and the school and will be a vehicle for parent consultation and feedback. It will allow school leaders to gauge parental opinion and perspective on a variety of issues. There will be an agenda published in advance of each meeting. Parents are also welcome to suggest agenda items. Parents / carers need to be aware that this group is not a forum for discussing individual concerns or provision for individual students. - Feedback from parents

Any presentations and reports shared at the meetings will be made available to all parents. All feedback taken will help the school to develop a better understanding of the views and needs of parents/carers and how we might address and incorporate them in school developments and practices. The benefits to parents /carers are that they will have a greater understanding of the way the school operates, have more information about their children's education and the quality of that education, will be able to contribute to the strategic direction of the school and share in the vision for the school.
