

It is also based around our School Expectations: Attendance, Behaviour & Curriculum and our School Values: Respect, Responsibility & Resilience





As a school we will:

- Provide a warm, friendly, welcoming, safe and secure learning environment.
- Ensure our Mission Statement and Gospel values are lived out in the daily life of the school.
- Check attendance & punctuality regularly & contact home with any concerns.
- Promote good behaviour. We will tackle any incidents of inappropriate behaviour quickly.
- Not allow the use of mobile phones in school.
- Provide a broad and balanced curriculum which challenges students to reach their potential and fulfils the requirements of the national curriculum.
- Encourage students to do their best and achieve their full potential.
- Promote positive values and a caring attitude towards the school community.
- Offer opportunities for parents to become involved in supporting their child's education.
- Contact home when concerns are raised about a student's work, behaviour, attendance or punctuality.
- Have a clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions for students, as set out in the school's Behaviour Policy.
- Communicate between home and school through notices, newsletters, the school website, emails and parents' evenings.
- Value and celebrate individual students' achievements.
- Keep parents/carers informed about their child's attendance, behaviour and progress.
- Work collaboratively with parents/carers to resolve any issues or problems as they arise.
- Allow students safe and secure use of the internet through a combination of site filtering, supervision and by fostering a responsible attitude in all students, in partnership with parents to implement a whole-school approach to online safety.
- Send home an annual report on your child's progress.

As a parent / carer I will:

- Work in partnership with the school and respect its Catholic Ethos in the education of my child.
- Accept the school's aims, values, policies and procedures and positively support the school.
- Ensure that my child attends school every day punctually, unless there is a good reason.
- Notify the school promptly before 8.30am in the event of an absence.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines on learning, behaviour, attendance and uniform.
- Accept the school's mobile phone policy and support the sanctions if my child's phone is seen
 or heard.
- Ensure that my child attends after school detentions and be responsible for their safe travel home.
- Ensure that my child's dinner account is in credit or inform school promptly if there is an issue.
- Support my child with homework that is set and ensure that this is completed on time.
- Inform the school promptly of any concerns or problems that may affect my child's learning, behaviour or happiness at school.
- Stay informed and up-to-date with the school community by regularly reading notices, newsletters, the school website and emails.
- Support the school in the teaching of safe and secure internet use at home.
- Attend parent meetings with teachers to discuss my child's achievements and progress.
- Inform the school immediately of any changes to my emergency contacts details.
- Treat staff with courtesy and respect.
