#### OUR SCHOOL DURING ADVENT

• AS WE BEGIN OUR ADVENT JOURNEY THE COLOUR PURPLE WILL

BE VERY VISIBLE THROUGHOUT THE SCHOOL. IT IS THE

LITURGICAL COLOUR FOR THE SEASON OF ADVENT. BOTH HALLS

WILL BE OUR MAIN VISUAL FOCAL POINTS FOR ADVENT, WITH

ONE OF OUR NATIVITY CRIBS TO BE SET UP IN ST MARY'S HALL.

• AS ONE OF OUR VIRTUES THIS HALF TERM IS JUSTICE, THIS YEAR WE WILL ALSO BE CREATING A VISUAL ADVENT DISPLAY OF OUR OWN. EACH PUPIL AND MEMBER OF STAFF WILL RECEIVE A CHRISTMAS TAG, ON WHICH THEY CAN WRITE A MESSAGE OF JUSTCE FOR ONE PERSON IN THEIR LIFE THAT THEY ARE TRULY GRATEFUL FOR. THESE WILL BE PLACED ON BOTH CHRISTMAS TREES AND PUPILS AND STAFF WILL BE INVITED TO STOP AND READ.

#### PRAYER STATIONS

- DURING ADVENT WE WILL BE CHANGING OUR PRAYER CLOTH TO THE COLOUR PURPLE.AS ALWAYS THESE WILL BE OUR FOCAL POINTS TO BE USED DURING TIMES OF PRAYER AND REFLECTION DURING FORM TIME AND LESSONS.
- THESE SPACES WILL BE OWNED BY THE PUPILS ENSURING THAT THEY ARE USED APPROPRIATELY, ARE WELL-CARED FOR AND ARE CONDUCIVE TO PRAYER. TWO PUPILS FROM EACH FORM WILL BE NOMINATED TO LOOK AFTER THE PRAYER STATION ON BEHALF OF THE FORM GROUP.
- DURING TIMES OF PRAYER AND REFLECTION (INCLUDING LITURGIES) STAFF WILL BE INVITED TO LIGHT THE CANDLE AS A SYMBOL THAT JESUS, THE LIGHT OF OUR WORLD, IS PRESENT WITH US AT THIS SACROSANCT TIME.

  - EACH DAY, THE SHORT REFLECTION WILL FOCUS ON A DIFFERENT ASPECT ON THE RUN UP TO CHRISTMAS, PUPILS WILL BE INVITED TO PAUSE, REFLECT AND PRAY.
