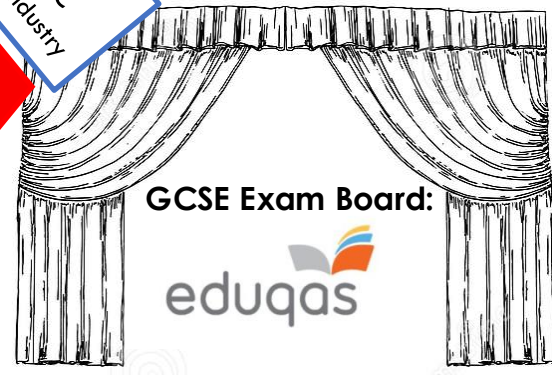

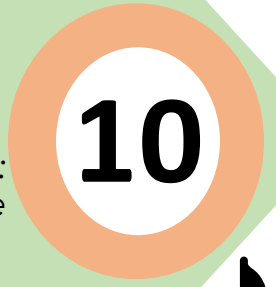

9.2 | Shakespeare Romeo & Juliet

Continuing their work on Shakespeare, pupils will further explore the characters and plot around R&J.

9.3 | Devising

NEW! Unit 9.3 is a shortened version of the KS4 devising unit: what can you create using the given stimulus.

9.1 | Devising & Characterisation

Pupils begin the year looking at how scripts can be adapted and will begin devising their own pieces based on a number of stimulus / scripts.

8.3 | Villains: Macbeth

Pupils explore Shakespeare's Macbeth: the characters, the plot, the motives and work these themes into their drama.

7.3 | Shakespeare A Midsummer Nights Dream

As an introduction to Shakespeare, pupils will explore the plot and characters of MND.

8.1 | Creating Fiction

Pupils explore a range of theatre genres and begin their group work of devising, linking to KS4.

8.2 | Theatre on Stage

NEW! Exploring the work of theatre on stage: from musicals to plays. This links with 8.1 in Music where pupils are looking at Musicals.

7.2 | Poetry

Pupils explore a range of poetry and use these poems as a stimulus to create a variety of Drama pieces.

7.1 | Intro to Drama

An introduction to Drama at secondary school; what is Drama? Pupils begin to explore basic techniques.
