As we reach the latter part of the academic year, we start to turn our attention to transitioning into the next academic year and ensuring success right from the start.

Assessment across the year comes in a variety of ways; key word tests, knowledge test, verbal questions and answer and extended written tasks. More formal assessments focus on POP (Proof of Progress) tasks with feedback targeted with a WWW (what went well) comment and EBI (even better if...) comment or challenge question which is specific and leads to a further task which demonstrates further improvements. These tasks are responded to by pupils in green pen so that progress is very visual.

Across the coming weeks pupils will be working towards their final assessments of the academic year and it is vital they spend time preparing for these following the guidance of their teachers, completing homework and revising key words for relevant topics. Year 10 have already had information about their mock examinations sent home.
