






















READING

A reading from the Holy Gospel according to John.

Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. Early in the morning he came again to the temple; all the people came to him, and he sat down and taught them. The scribes and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in adultery, and placing her in the middle they said to him,

"Teacher, this woman has been caught in the act of adultery.





Let us think about the pain and suffering Immaculee went through.







Have I listened to Jesus' words of hope, or have I allowed myself to lose heart?
