- Flowers grow from seeds (Rec)

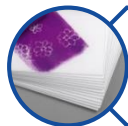
Key Knowledge

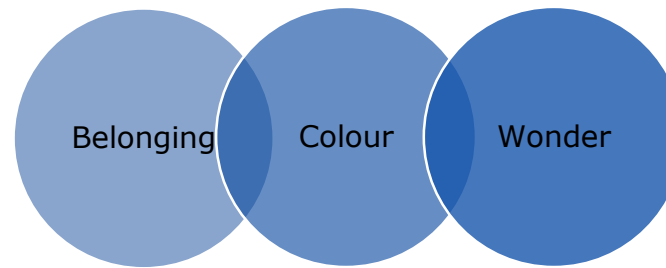
Polystyrene tile
