A student's progress is severely hampered if they do not regularly attend school.

98-100%	Expected
95-97%	Satisfactory
95%-90%	A cause for concern – at risk of becoming persistently absent
Below 90%	Persistently absent
Below 80%	Severe / Chronic absence

- > 90% attendance is an average of one day out of school per fortnight over a school year.
- 90% attendance over 5 years at secondary school is half a school year missed.
- > 80% attendance over 5 years at secondary school is the same as one whole school year missed.

I have included the above information on attendance as this is a hot topic in the press this week and new rules come into force regarding improving this nationally. Our attendance remains above average however please be mindful of this when booking holidays as I have had a number of requests which unfortunately I cannot authorise. School fully understand the savings that can be made so hopefully this national conversation will bring the price of holidays down.
