

Nursery Curriculum Goals

In line with the new Statutory Framework for Early Years, we have developed a set of Curriculum Goals that are used for both planning and assessment. These skills reflect the early year's practitioners understanding of the skills that the children need to be able to successfully access the Reception Curriculum next year. There is a goal for each of the seven areas of learning but most of the goals cover other areas of learning too.

Goal 1- 1. To sequence three parts of a familiar story using sequencing cards

2. Perform two nursery rhyme

(Literacy and EAD)

Goal 2- To echo back new, ambitious vocabulary that has been introduced (Communication and Language)

Goal 3- Children reflect on their learning (Personal Social and Emotional Development)

Goal 4- To describe who is in their immediate family, friends and routines. (Understanding the World)

Goal 5- To suggest how to make someone feel better

(Personal Social and Emotional Development)

Goal 6- To form the initial letter in my name (Physical Development)

Goal 7- To subitise numbers up to 5 (Maths)
