

Reception Curriculum Goals

In line with the new Statutory Framework for Early Years, we have developed a set of Curriculum Goals that are used for both planning and assessment. These skills reflect the early year's practitioners understanding of the skills that the children need to be able to successfully access the Year One Curriculum next year. There is a goal for each of the seven areas of learning but most of the goals cover other areas of learning too.

Goal 1- To be able to retell a familiar story (Literacy and EAD)

Goal 2- To use ambitious vocabulary (Communication and Language)

Goal 3- Children will be resilient and independent learners (Personal Social and Emotional Development)

Goal 4- Children have an enriched understanding of their world and the world around them (Understanding the World)

Goal 5- Children recognise their own feelings and those of others and begin to self-regulate independently (Personal Social and Emotional Development)

Goal 6- To hold a pencil accurately and write my name independently (Physical Development)

Goal 7- To be able to buy an item from a shop (Maths)

Goal 8- Children are able to decode and blend words to read books (suitable for their age group) (Reading)
