

School Council – 31.01.20

Focus of the meeting today was to review the current rewards on offer for achieving a gold card

- First Lunch – School Council discussed that if you have a Gold Card, then you should be able to go to lunch first. This would mean that at the beginning of the Service, all gold card children could have first lunch. Currently they are only at the front of the line for their year group.
- Tables in the lunch hall for Gold Card Club – these could be a couple of longer rectangular tables. Representatives requested that we have decorations and a gold table cloth, perhaps crackers on some days as well.

- Sitting on a bench for assembly – making sure that there are enough benches.
- Key Stage 1 Representatives said that they enjoyed the indoor club, but would like to have one outside as well.
- School Lunches – Ms Cooper explained that the company who run the canteen are changing after half term. Representatives requested that we have milk introduced again as it is ‘nice and good for your teeth’. Ms Cooper is going to ask Becky to contact the catering company.
