All children have been heavily involved in designing the curriculum. This exciting curriculum offers all learners, particularly those from a disadvantaged background (57% of the pupils being PPG) opportunities to explore and develop real life skills through meaningful projects. These projects give children an understanding of the world 'beyond Ladbroke Grove'.

During our recent Ofsted inspection in March 2023, the school was graded as Good with two elements of Outstanding, namely Behaviour and Attitudes and Personal Development. This recognised the tireless work and dedication of the staff team to strive for success for all enabling the pupils to face life's challenges with innovation and a desire to succeed.

The school has been fortunate enough to have four years of capital project development with significant renovation. This includes the re-modelling and renovation of key buildings to house the ASD provision which comprises of facilities for 16 children in both Key Stage One and Two.
