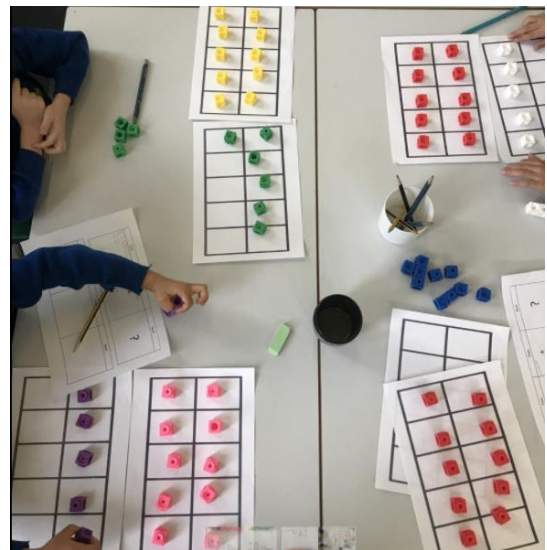


Gremlin Class
