

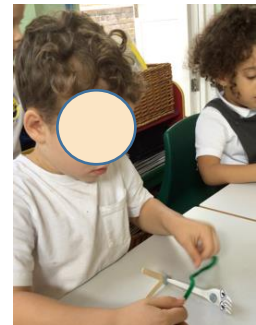


What an incredible start to the year we have had! The children in Gremlin class have been superstars!

This term our IPC topic is 'My World' and we are learning to be scientists. Our topic is about everyday materials we use in our world. The children have been learning about the different materials used in everyday objects. They are beginning to understand the differences and can name the different properties for certain materials. We experimented to see what materials would float and sink. Well done Gremlins.



We have been looking at Toy Story this week. The children are learning how to following instructions, using sequencing with numbers, time connectives and bossy verbs. Here they are making their own Forkie, following instructions very well. They are beginning to use time connectives and bossy verbs independently.



Gremlin class has fantastic mathematicians. This week we have been adding and subtracting numbers. The children have begun to understand that it is efficient practice to count on from the bigger number. They can use a number line, a bead string and record their equations.
