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Today we took part in an investigation to build strong, sturdy bridges! We started by learning about the different types of bridges and exploring why these structures need to be stable and strong. We sketched the design that we thought would work best before working in teams to make our bridges using only straws, lolly sticks, card, sellotape, scissors and string. We paused to evaluate our bridges and considered how to reinforce them before testing their effectiveness with a toy car.
