


Gnome Class End of Year Web Update

Here are some of our favourite pieces of work from Year 2!





Even though we haven't been able to go on any trips this year, we have had lots of fun learning outside in lots of different lessons!




We also recently had a great time taking part in football, hockey, javelin and relay races during Sports Day at the Westway!
