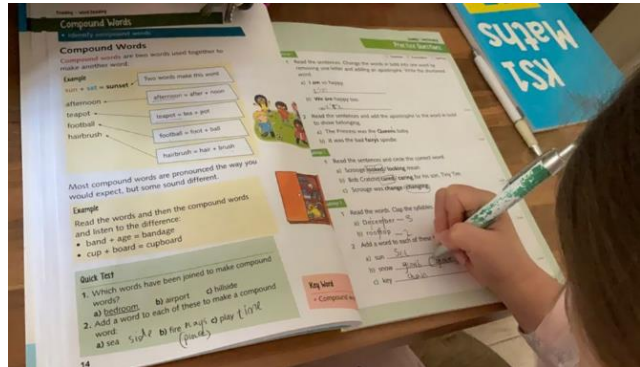
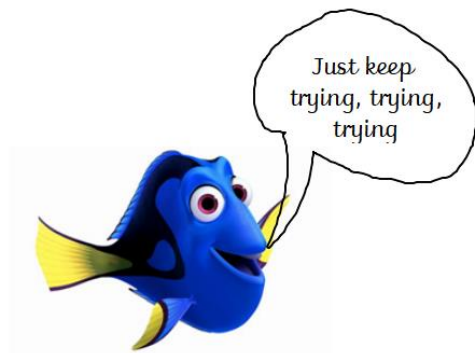
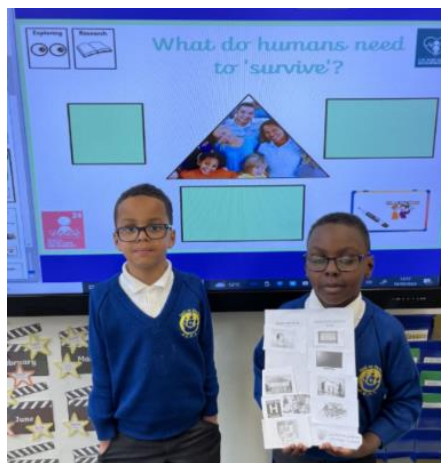


Gnome Class Web Update
