

Dragon Class Update

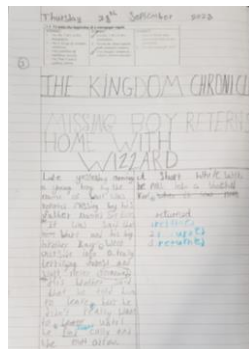
We are off to a positive start in Year 4 with everyone now settled into their new learning environment and routine.
