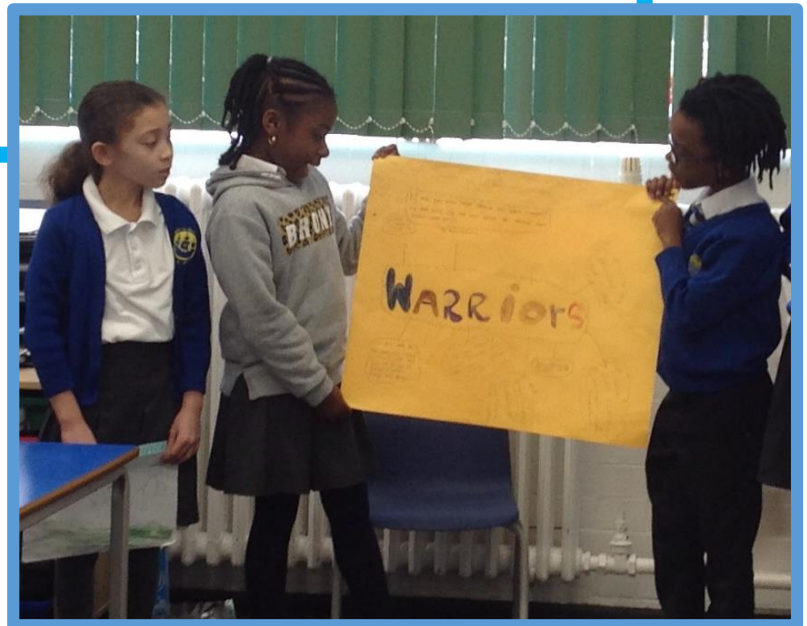

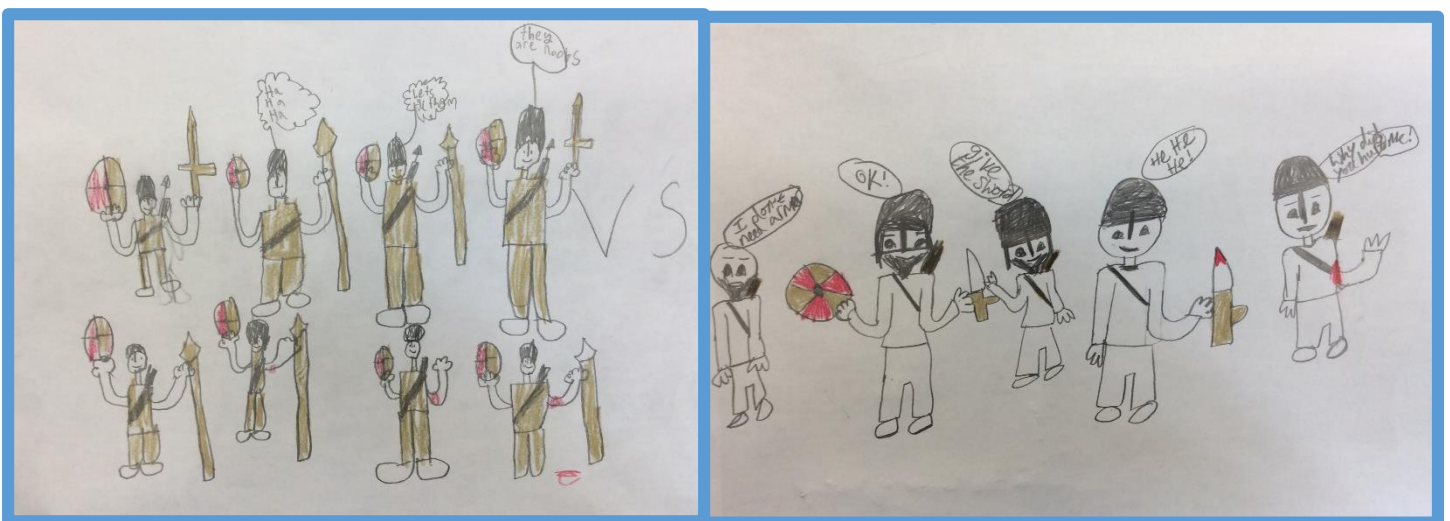
## Building a Village

This illustration shows a Viking vs Anglo Saxon battle.



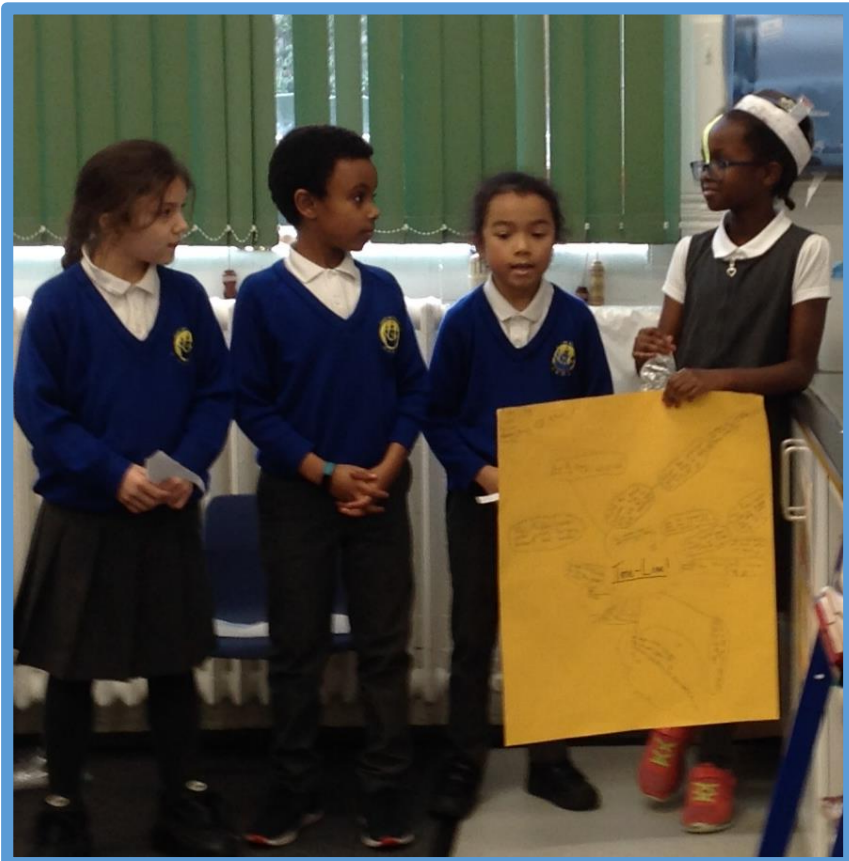
