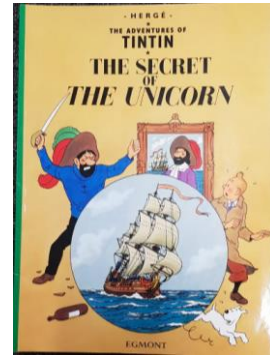


Centaur Web Update

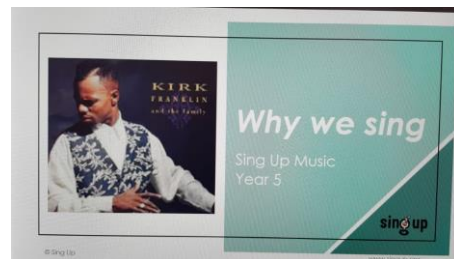
In Literacy, we have started looking at our new text called 'The adventures of TinTin – The Secret of the Unicorn'. We have read the beginning of the story and been introduced to the characters. One character that we have come across is the pickpocket, who has stolen wallets at the local market. This has given us the opportunity to develop our reporting skills as we took on the role of a police detective to interview the victims and write up our own police report.



In Maths, we have been focusing on measurement. We started the term off by looking at time, which allowed us the chance to convert between 12 hour and 24 hour clocks. We then had the opportunity to learn how to convert imperial units of measure and solve problems associated with this. On Thursday, we consolidated our learning by completing an investigation on measurement, which gave us the chance to use specific measuring equipment related to capacity, length and weight.

In IPC, we have started our new topic 'Going Global'. At the beginning of the term we had our entry point, where we explored globalisation and what it means to be a global citizen. Following some learning that helped us understand the purpose of flags and what they represent, we designed our own. We then went on to take part in an international trading game. In the game, we traded-in eight different world commodities, such as cocoa beans, bananas, gold, cattle, oil, rice, cotton and gas. We then had to have a go at importing and exporting these commodities. However, three teams were economically wealthy countries and the other three were economically developing countries. We discussed if this was fair and how this happens in the world daily.

As a class, we have also been enjoying our music lessons, where we have been exploring Gospel music and developing our skills such as; recognising instruments and voices by ear, identifying key elements that give music it's unique sound and developing our techniques for singing and performing in a gospel style.



We have also been preparing for our Ramadan and Eid assembly, which takes place on **Thursday 4th May**. The rehearsals have been going well and we cannot wait for you all to see the hard work we have put into it.
