We then discussed why we can wear odd socks on anti-bullying day, to show that our differences are what



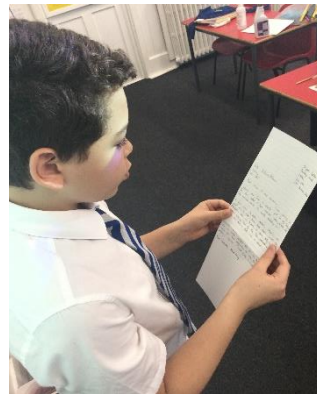
make us unique. We all understand the importance of being respectful of others' differences.
