When did world war 2 take place?

World war two started in 1939 when Germany invaded Poland. Great Britain and France responded by declaring war on Germany. The war in Europe ended with Germany's surrender on May 7 1945. The war in the Pacific finished by Japan surrendering on September 2 1945.

Who was involved in WW2?

World war 2, also called second World War, conflict that involved virtually every part of the world during 1939-45. The principal belligerents were the Axis powers - Germany, Italy and Japan.
