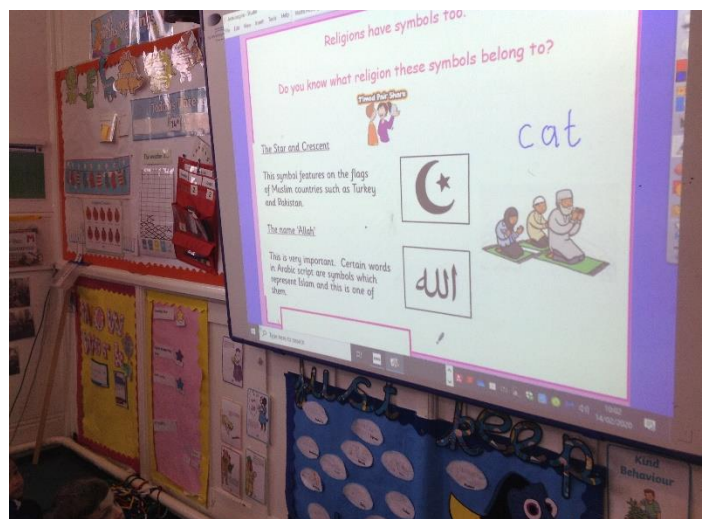
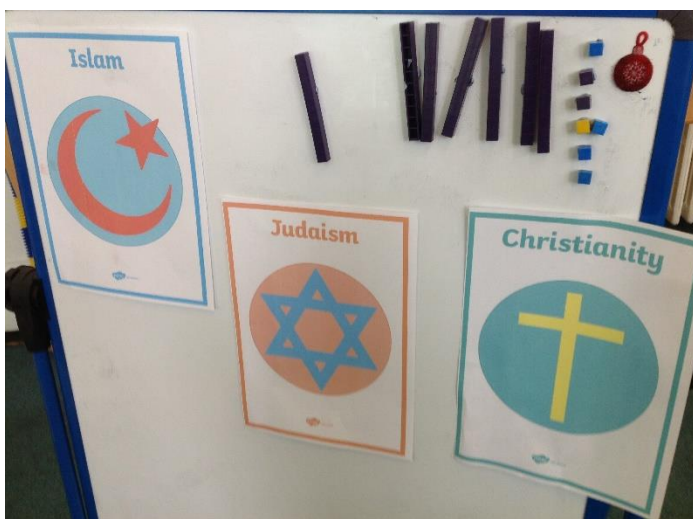
Have look at what we have been up to during our R.E days last half term.

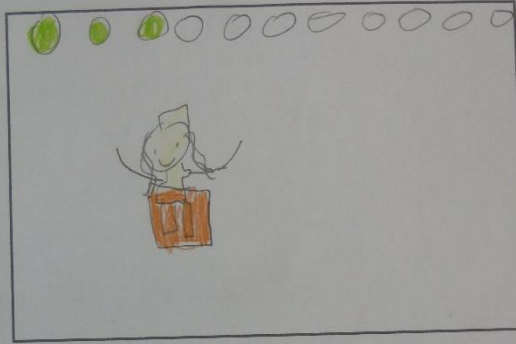




In Year 1 we found out about different symbols that important to a variety of religions. We explored which symbols belonged to what religion and why they were important. We then explored symbols that were important to us.



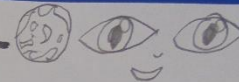
Religious Miracles

The world religions




Name of faith: Sikhism

How do you think the artefact is used? (Suggest at least two uses)


I think that the artefact is used as a shrine. Perhaps the statue is used to communicate to god.
