

Sensory Stories

Title: Superworm	Theme: Summer Term- Animals
Learning Intention: To bring narrative to life using sensory experiences, engaging attention, developing communication and encouraging interaction.	
Equipment: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stretchy worm • Crushed brown cereal in zip lock bag containing minibeasts. • Black Feathers • Lizards • Nets • Treasure (coins) • Bucket • Spoon (depending on ability) 	

Superworm

Use prompts to retell the story, allow all children to have adequate time in between each sensory experience.

Introduction to the story- Superworm	
Superworm is super long, superworm is super strong. Watch him wiggle! see him squirm! Hooray for Superworm!	Let the children explore the stretchy worm.
The Crow is black and grim. Everyone is scared of him!	Stroke feathers on child's arm.
Superworm is captured for lizard, lizard is his boss.	Let the children explore lizard.
Superworm digs for treasure for lizard and crow. Superworm is in trouble! We must help him if we can, we must hatch a cunning plan!	Let the children look for treasure in the crushed cereal. (Children can use hands or spoons depending on capability.)
The spiders weave a web. The web is strong, the web is tough! Th web is plenty big enough!	Drape the net over the child's arms or face. Encourage child to explore the net.
The lizard is captured by the minibeasts and dumped into the rubbish pile!	Get the children to hold the net with lizard caught inside and place in bucket.
Superworm is free at last!	Children to explore stretchy worms.
