Use prompts to retell the story, allow all children to have adequate time in between each sensory experience.

SSSSSS- A snake looking for his tea.	Rain maker for sound Snake material for texture.
Creeping through the jungle, what can you see, can you hear a noise what could it be?	Green scarves and magnifying glasses
Grrrrrr- A tiger looking for his tea.	Slide for Auditory Hand Puppet
Running through the jungle, what can you see, can you hear a noise- what could it be?	Green scarves and magnifying glasses
Elephant Noise- An Elephant looking for his tea.	Slide for auditory Water squirter
Leaping through the jungle, what can you see, can you hear a noise- what could it be?	Green scarves and magnifying glasses
Rrrrrr- A Lion looking for his tea.	Slide for auditory Hand puppet
Swinging through the jungle, what can you see, can you hear a noise- what could it be?	Green scarves and magnifying glasses
Monkey Noise- A monkey looking for his tea.	Slide for auditory Hand puppet
Wading through the jungle, what can you see, can you hear a noise- what could it be?	Green scarves and magnifying glasses
Snap snap snap- a crocodile looking for his tea.	Slide for auditory Wind up crocodile toy in water.
