Actions for Curriculum Coverage Spring/Summer 2021

All Staff:

- Assess Autumn learning in maths, reading, spelling. This could be done through:
 - Short assessment tasks both practical and written
 - Moderation of work to assess application
 - Diagnostic questioning to assess depth of understanding and misconceptions.
 - Running records for book banded children.
 - Phonics screens where appropriate
 - Times table screen where appropriate.
- Assess learning delivered during lockdown through assessment 2-week block. This was planned prior to return (detailed on school website)
- Plan for recap of missed learning as a result of lockdown, and also areas identified to be insecure. This could be through:
 - Additional cross-curricular links to embed maths and English skills.
 - Identifying QFT based interventions to support closing the gap which has developed as a result of lockdown. This could be from ILOP, White Rose Maths, Classroom Secrets, Every Child Counts (KS1/Y3) or own materials.
 - Planning short blocked units to embed and secure knowledge, where appropriate.
 - Delivered newly consolidated units for this year only, if highlighted within year group curriculum coverage map.
