Parentpay Information

Thank you to everyone for keeping your Parentpay accounts topped up, we do appreciate your help.

If you find you are not remembering to top up before a child takes a meal or snack, please have a look at the following link below:

The webpage shows how you can set up alerts to let you know that the funds are getting low on your account and this will help you to top up on time. We would suggest putting an alert level of:

£1.00 if your child only has snack
£2.40 if your child only has a meal
£3.20 if your child has a snack and meal

Please note that email alerts are free but if you choose text alerts, you have to add funds to pay for them. Alternatively, you could always set a reminder on your phone or electrical device (eg Alexa, Google Home) to check your child's balance each week (perhaps on a Sunday).

If you are topping up for a full week, please note that a full week of meals is £12 plus any snacks that your child may take each day per item per day: snacks are 18p milk, 30p juice and 25p each for all other items.
