We will continue to work on phase 3 phonics

To label a picture using phase 2/3 phonics

Writing simple captions

To write a simple sentence, including capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Introduces a storyline or narrative into their play. Plays alongside other children who are engaged in the same theme.

Plays cooperatively as part of a group to develop and act out a narrative

## Maths

We will continue to look at exploring patterns and create more complex repeating patterns.

We will begin to counting forward/backwards.

We will develop our counting to 20 and number recognition to 20.

We will be ordering/missing numbers/counting forward and backwards from 0 and back to 20.
