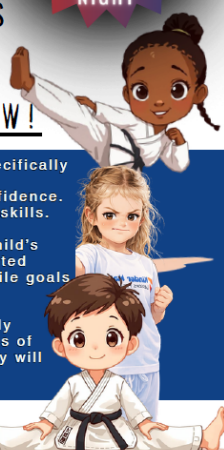

Fox Cycling at Park Road Primary School

Fox Cycling is working in partnership with Park Road Primary School to help more children develop the skills and confidence to ride a bike.

From October, Fox Cycling will be delivering **Balance Bike sessions for Reception and Year 1 children during the school day**, with bikes and helmets provided by Fox Cycling and the school.

Fox Cycling will also be based at **Park Road Primary School every Saturday**, offering:

- **Cycle Tots** – balance bike classes for children aged 2½ – 5 years
- **1-to-1 Learn to Cycle lessons** – individual coaching for children learning to ride independently
- **Cycle Improvers** – group sessions for children who can already pedal but need to develop their confidence and cycling skills
