### School Grounds Enhancement

We are pleased to let you know that we have had agreement from the Omega Multi Academy Trust to implement some improvements to the school environment..

There will be work in the Early Years (Reception class) to give more space to play when it is raining and improve the provision in this area.

The playground is to be resurfaced, the fencing and substation doors at the front of school will be replaced. In addition to this, we are hoping to improve the drainage on site, improve the paths to prevent them flooding and install a cycle hut near to the KS2 gate.

The interactive boards in the classrooms will all be replaced.

As you will appreciate, it may take some time to implement all of the changes but we hope you will soon be able to see the results!

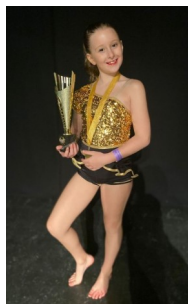
### **Thank you Mrs B and Tesco**

### **Abbie Cook's Fundraising Story**

Abbie Cook's life changed immeasurably in January 2016 when her son Jackson was born. Then, in the March, he was diagnosed with a serious heart defect and has been cared for under Alder Hey Children's Hospital ever since. He had 2 open heart surgeries within 18 months with further multiple smaller surgeries and procedures up to now. They will continue to care for him until he is at least 18.



Jackson is Abbie's little miracle but he, and many others, wouldn't be here if it wasn't for this hospital and the work they do, the amazing doctors, surgeons, nurses and all the other staff members that work there.

Alder Hey Children's Charity purchases life saving equipment, provides magic moments and funds essential research for the 330,000 patients and families under their care every year. Abbie's team are taking on Snowdon on the night of 15-16 April along with many others to raise money for this wonderful hospital and anything you can give to support them would be greatly received.

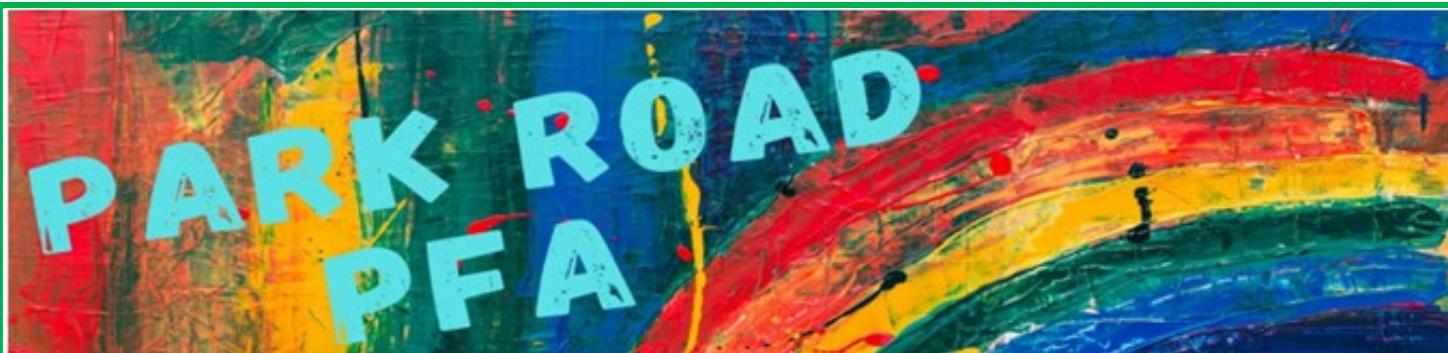
As our local children's hospital, you never know when you might need them, as we know too well that life is unpredictable and can change in a heartbeat.

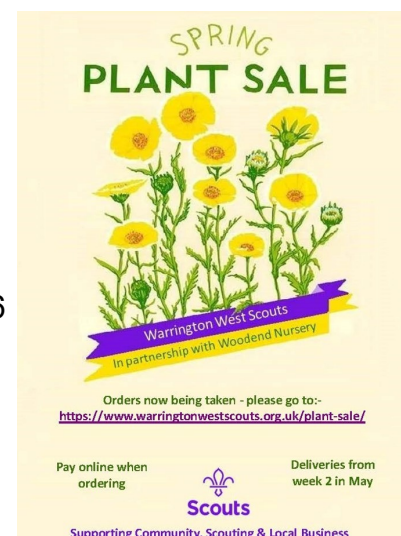

### Little Rescuers

Active Future are offering clubs during the holidays for income based free school meals. The clubs will run from Wednesday 5 April through to Friday 14 April. Alongside these clubs there is an extremely valuable course for young people to learn on offer, as here in the UK there is an 8% chance of surviving a cardiac arrest whereas in some states in America and Scandinavian countries there is a 54% chance of survival as people are taught first aid from as young as nursery age. It will include various modules in how the human heart works, how young people can check if someone is conscious, how to effectively dial 999 and also how to effectively put someone in the recovery position.
