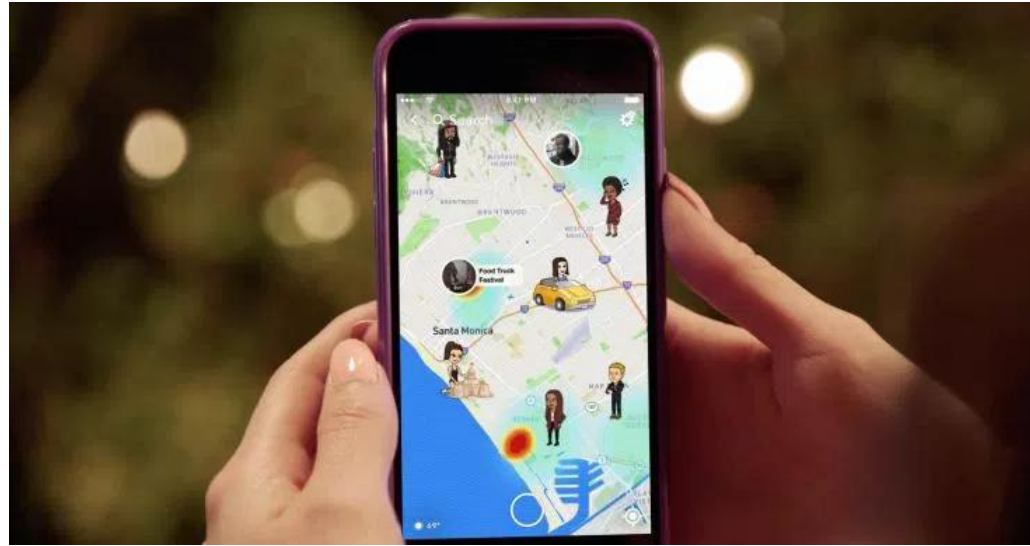


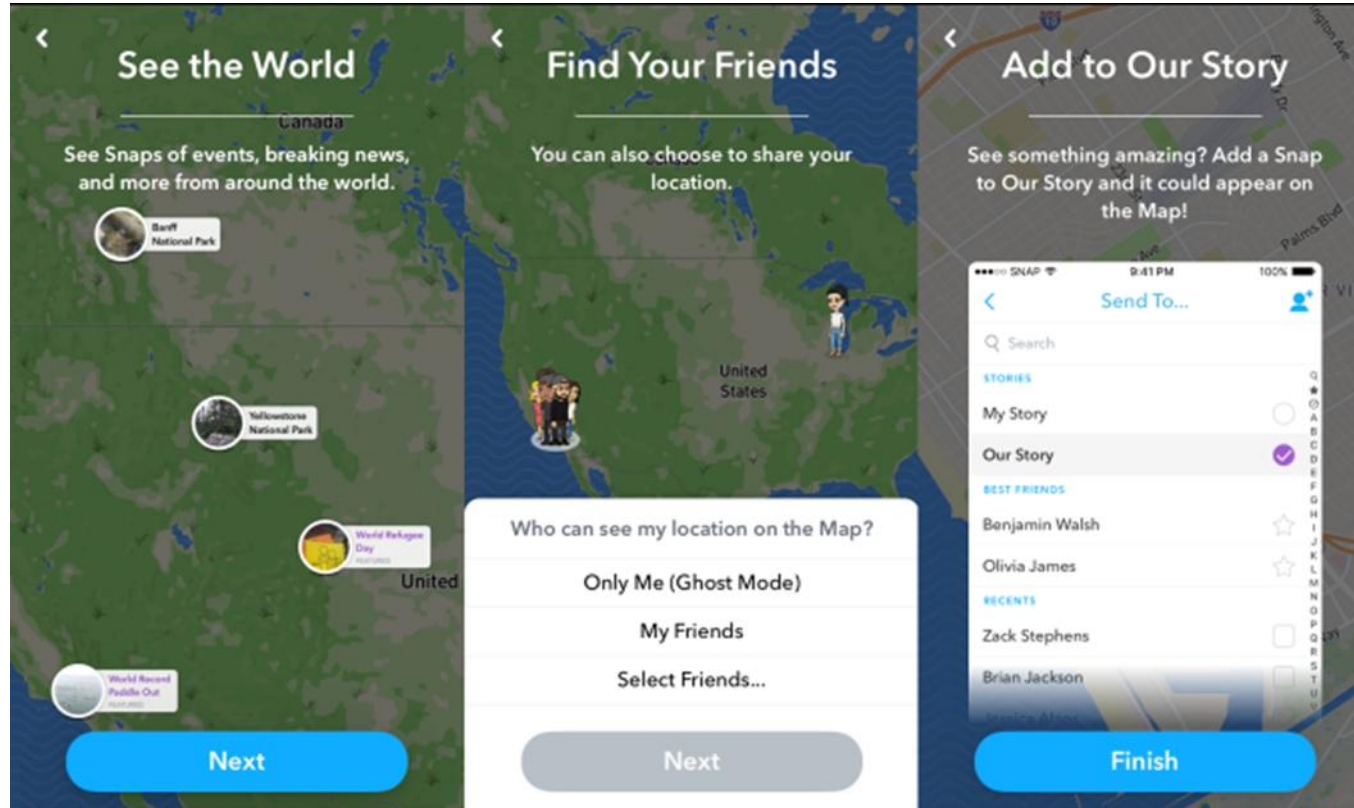
# Snap Map and how to disable it.



Snap Map lets people search for places such as schools and see videos and pictures posted by children inside.

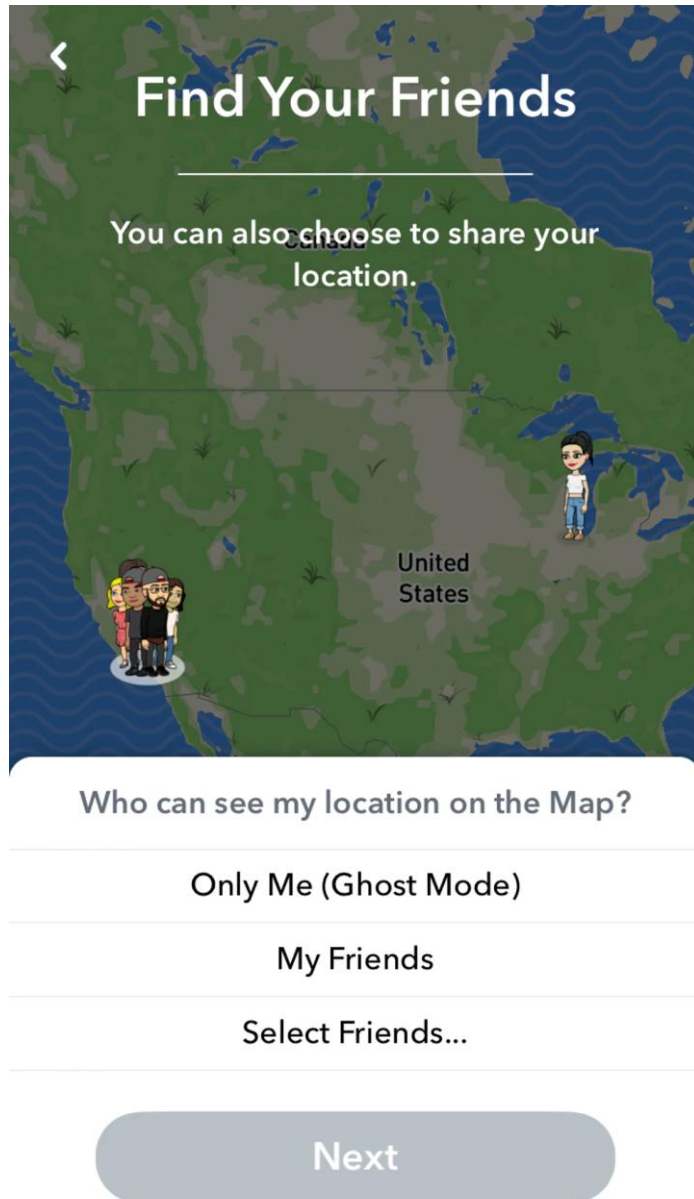
It also lets people locate their "friends" on a map that is accurate enough to determine where people live.

# Snap Map and how to disable it.



To access the Snap Map, you pinch on your Snapchat camera home screen. From there you can scroll around to see where friends are in your city or around the world. Tapping on their “ActionMoji” BitMoji avatar opens their Story to show what they’re up to, or lets you message them directly to make meetup plans. Snapchat automatically picks an ActionMoji for you based on your location, time of day and other factors.

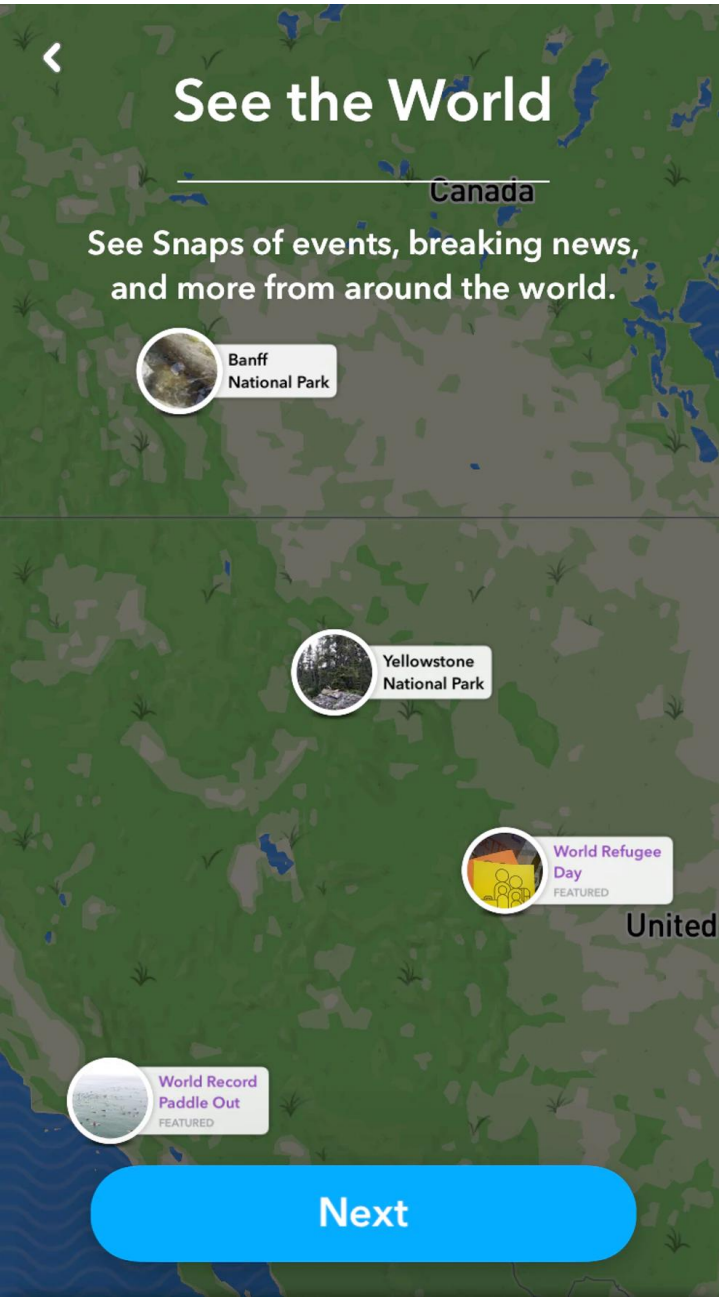
## Ghost Mode

As a first step you can do what Snapchat is calling, "ghost mode."

When you choose this feature, your Bitmoji will disappear from the map and no longer be visible to any of your friends.

It's important to note that you can also make your Snap Map Bitmoji available to select friends.

## Turn Off Location Services

To keep yourself safe you will also need to turn off your location services and disconnect. To use Snap Map, you will have had to turn it on in settings, so just return there to turn it off.

While the idea of constantly keeping up with your friends and their travels sounds appealing, if Snap Map doesn't give you enough privacy, using one of those options could be ideal. As always social media is for enjoyment and you should make sure that you **keep safe** .
